

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PRAIRIE LAKES

BY-LAW NO. 5, 2015

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PRAIRIE LAKES TO ADOPT POLICIES TO STANDARDIZE OPERATIONS AND DEVELOPMENT ISSUES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS Section 250 (1) and 231 of *The Municipal Act* provides as follows;

“ 250 (1) A municipality is a corporation and, subject to this *Act*, has the rights and is subject to the liabilities of a corporation and may exercise its powers for municipal purposes.”

“231 The power given to a council under this Division to pass by-laws is stated in general terms

- (a) to give broad authority to the council and to respect its right to govern the municipality in whatever way the council considers appropriate, within the jurisdiction given to it under this and other Acts; and
- (b) to enhance the ability of the council to respond to present and future issues in the municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Prairie Lakes deem it expedient and in the best interest of the municipality to adopt policies to enhance the ability of the Council to respond to present and future issues in the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Rural Municipality of Prairie Lakes, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1) THAT the municipality do establish a Policies and Standards Manual;
- 2) THAT Policies be adopted by Resolution of Council and appended to the Policies and Standards manual;
- 3) THAT the Reeve and the Chief Administrative Officer of the Rural Municipality of Prairie Lakes be, and are hereby authorized and directed to execute said document and to execute such further documents and instruments as may be necessary to give effect to the intent thereto.

DONE AND PASSED, as a By-Law, by the Council of The Rural Municipality of Prairie Lakes, in Council duly assembled, at Belmont, in the Province of Manitoba, this 14<sup>th</sup> day of January, A.D. 2015.
